GM Johnson is pleased to announce the availability of the following computer generated maps for scuba divers.

HMCS Mackenzie Artificial Reef Map

For \$4.95 the artificial reef map describes the wreck, its situation, and history. The map shows a Side Depth, Plan, Bridge, Operations Deck and Number 2 through Number 5 Deck Views. All views showing access holes to exterior and other diver information. The map contains additional information on how to get there, diver etiquette, emergencies, hazards, reminders, tides and currents, water visibility and temperatures, yearly weather, marine life and protection and area amenities. The wreck is located near Victoria, BC.

The map is built using 3D Computer Aided Design Modelling Software. The author Bernie Kyle a scuba diver himself used simulated fractured light and shadowing effects to the computer model to enhance the realism of the underwater wreck graphics.

The scale of the map is 1:300, which means that 1 centimetre represents 3 metres or 1 inch represents 25 feet on the map. The map is in full color, is 17" by 28" in size and printed on paper. The ISBN is 0-9699989-1-0.

Whytecliff Marine Park Map

For \$14.95 this map is water and tear proof printed in full color on synthetic paper. The map can be taken with the diver underwater. The maps shows underwater contours and in addition contains a section on Marine Life in the Park. Whytecliff park is located in the urban area of Vancouver BC. The scale of the map is 1:1500, the size is 16" by 36", has ISBN of 0-9699989-0-2 and the author is Bernie Kyle.
